The motion was brought on consent, in writing.

The plaintiff, on her behalf and on behalf of putative class members, commenced this proposed class action by way of a Statement of Claim issued on July 25, 2024. The statement of claim was served on the same day.

This action concerns "young persons" under the *Youth Criminal Justice Act*, S.C. 2002, c. 1 ("*YCJA*") who were routinely strip searched in youth custody facilities in the Province of Ontario between April 1, 2003 and the present. The action alleges that youth detained in youth custody facilities were subject to routine, suspicionless strip searches in violation of their *Charter* rights and harmed them.

Since commencing this action, counsel for the plaintiff have been contacted by a significant number of putative class members who have provided additional information about the conditions in youth custody facilities.

Counsel for the plaintiff have also received responses to freedom of information requests as part of their ongoing investigation, which have resulted in certain new information coming to light.

Since the commencement of this action, there have also been a number of decisions rendered by Ontario courts regarding some putative class members.

The proposed Amended Statement of Claim captures this new information. The defendant has not served a statement of defence and the pleadings are not yet closed.

The proposed amendments do not change the nature of this proposed class action or the case to be defended by the defendant.

The addition of a new plaintiff who was subject to the alleged conduct, and the amendment of the statement of claim at this stage, cause no prejudice to any party.
